HIV PROGRAM TRANSFORMATION

4 game changing strategies, new organizational structure, integrated HIV prevention and treatment framework, \$462,146 in savings and efficiencies

IMPACT RESULTS

Reach: 20,764 key populations (*71% FY17 CDC goals*)

Test: 1,111/889 HIV+ cases (*125% FY17 CDC goals, 34% compared to FY16 CDC goals*)

Treat: 80% new HIV+ linked to ART Services (>90% in GUA, NIC, PN, 5 Decentralized ART Services, HIVDR Survey in WHO 2017 Report)
